The competition judged by the presidents of local chapters of PSPE and NJSPE will be December 1st. Awardees will be honored at the Engineers' Week Luncheon hosted by the Engineers' Club of Philadelphia on February 17th, and at our own PSPE Engineers' Week Banquet February 25th.
